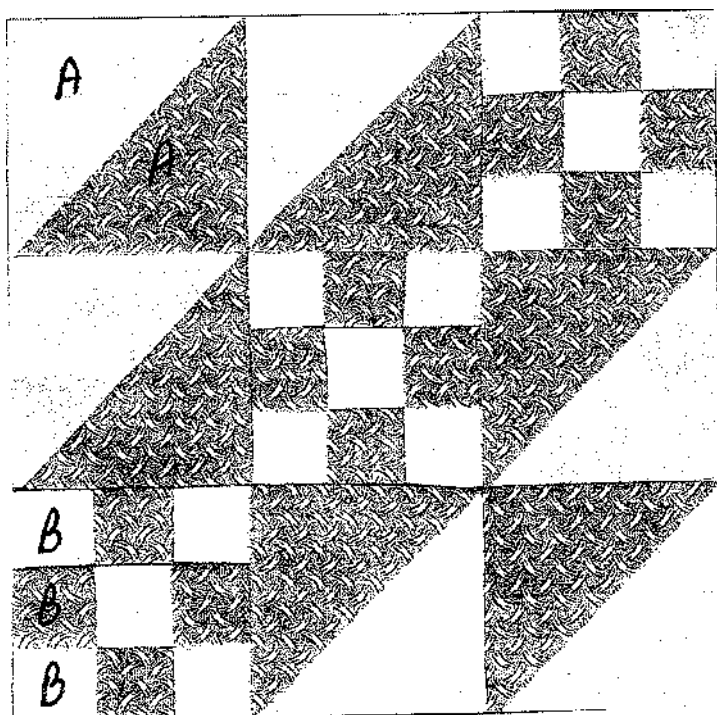


## Block of the Month, March 2010 - Jacob's Ladder Variation



### FABRICS

Dark – blue or plum  
Light – creamy white

Cutting: Dark: 3 squares 3 7/8"  
2 strips 1 1/2" wide x 6" long  
1 strip 1 1/2" x 12" long

Light: 3 squares 3 7/8"  
2 strips 1 1/2" x 12" long  
1 strip 1 1/2" x 6" long

Piecing: Make the A block by placing a light and dark square right sides together. Draw a diagonal line on the light fabric and sew 1/4" on each side of this line. Cut apart on drawn line, press towards dark fabric and trim resulting square to 3 1/2".

Sew a 12" strip set of light, dark, light and a 6" strip set of dark, light, dark. Press to dark fabric. Sub-cut these strips into 1 1/2" sections. Sew 1 1/2" sections together to form 6 9-patch blocks. These should measure 3 1/2" square when you finish.

Sew half-square triangles and 9-patches together according to diagram.

Unfinished - 9 1/2" square

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
