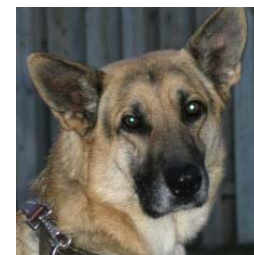
Please limit your narrative to no more than 50 words:

Please read the following entry requirements:

- 1) All bed, lap, crib/baby, and wall quilts require a sleeve for hanging. Please attach a hanging sleeve to the top of the quilt back. The method of attachment must not show on the front of the quilt.
- 2) Please attach a label to the bottom right or left corner of the back of your quilt, with your name, quilt title, city, province, and the words: "Donated to The Charlie Fund Quilt Event 2010".
- 3) Quilts received after the deadline of September 30, 2010 will be gratefully accepted for the 2011 fundraiser.
- 4) The value of your donation is determined by experienced quilters/quilt judges. Minimum opening bids on a quilt will be such as to promote a reasonable start for bidding, to assist in attendees' recognition of the quilt's value and discourage bargain hunting.
- 5) Quilts will be used at the discretion of The Charlie Fund for fundraising purposes, specifically for the emergency/special medical care of homeless animals at the Oakville & District Humane Society.



Your quilts will help raise funds to save ill and injured homeless animals. Every year, The Charlie Fund saves more than 150 dogs, cats and small companion animals who have been hit by cars, caught in traps, suffered neglect or abuse, or need special medical attention for life-threatening conditions. Every dollar raised by The Charlie Fund Quilt Event goes directly to these needy animals.

The Charlie Fund saves ill and injured homeless animals, thanks to generous donations from our supporters. In recent years, we have saved more than 150 dogs, cats and small companion animals annually. We care for animals hit by cars, caught in traps, attacked by predators, or suffering from neglect or abuse, as well as those with other life-threatening conditions. We purchase milk replacement products, which are used to feed orphaned kittens and puppies until they are old enough to eat solid foods.



This special/emergency medical fund runs solely on donations.

In 2009, we held the first Charlie Fund Silent Quilt Auction. Total proceeds from that event exceeded \$3,600.

This year, we are having a quilt show and “Buy It Now”, in addition to the silent quilt auction. There will also be other quilt- and pet-related attractions. *Every dollar raised will go directly to the medical needs and care of the animals.*

Attached is the “Entry Form for Quilts” for this year’s fundraising event. If you are able to donate your time and talent to create a quilt — large or small — to help an animal get a second chance at life, we would be most grateful. A tax receipt for the successful sale/bid amount for your donated project will be mailed to you.
